### Examination Centre Guidelines against COVID-19

In protection against the ongoing effect of COVID-19, ICAB has taken the following measures across all ICAB examination centres in order to ensure the safety of the candidates, executives and invigilators together with the assisting staff:

1. Candidates are advised to present themselves at the examination centre at least half an hour before the commencement of the examinations for safety reason from COVID-19 impact.
2. No candidate shall be permitted to enter the examination centre if s/he has been diagnosed with COVID-19 symptoms.
3. Candidates have been advised to stay apart from others as a part of COVID-19 precautionary measures all the way in the examination centre.
4. Wearing face masks for all are mandatory. Everybody is advised not to put off face mask at any point of examination centre area.
5. Candidates' face masks may be removed, if asked by the invigilator, for the purposes of verifying the identity of the candidate during the examination hours and s/he should wear the mask soon after the verification is over.
6. Candidates must cover their nose and mouth in case of sneezing or coughing.
